



Pinnacle Soccer Code of Conduct

Athletes on the Pinnacle Charter School soccer team will learn the skills and values necessary to succeed in the game of soccer while maintaining academic success.

Athletes must attend all possible practices and games. There are very few games, so it is important for all athletes to be present. If an athlete must miss a practice or game, the coach should be notified within 24 hours or as soon as possible. If an athlete has 2 or more unexcused absences (either practices or games), then they will serve a one game suspension.

Athletes will strive for academic achievement and will provide the coach with a weekly progress report every Friday. If any assignments are missing and/or there is a grade of N or U, the athlete will not play in the following game unless the assignments are turned in and they make improvements to their grade.

Athletes must always try their best and display sportsmanship. Any negative attitude and disrespectful language toward the coach, teammates, referee, or opponents will not be tolerated. Athletes will be asked to sit out of practice/games with any display of unsportsmanlike conduct. The coach will determine the amount of time depending upon the conduct of the athlete.

Remember: The actions of all athletes, coaches, and spectators represent and reflect upon Pinnacle Charter School; therefore everyone is expected to display high standards of sportsmanship and self-control throughout the season.
