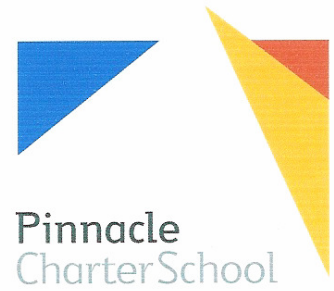

Lesson 2.13 Number Stories

- Students will practice making up and solving number stories.
- Students will review and practice counting money.
 - * Ex- You have a nickle , you buy 3 pieces of gum for 1 cent each. How much do you have left?

Lesson 2.14 Unit 2 Assessment

- Students will review and use the material covered in unit 2 to complete the assessment.
- Material on the test:
 - Telling time to the hour
 - Counting pennies and nickels
 - Trading pennies for nickels
