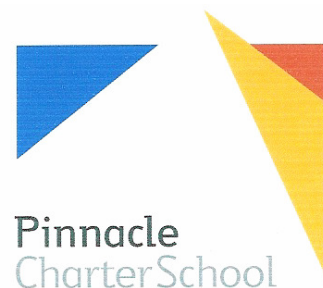

## Math Lessons 3.14 through 3.15 Domino Addition, Review, Assessment

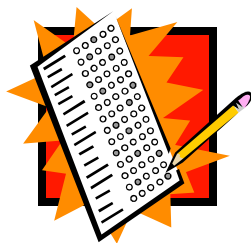
### Lesson 3.14 Domino Addition

- Students will be assessed on material covered in Unit 3.

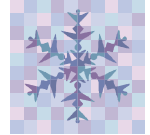




## Science and Social Studies
