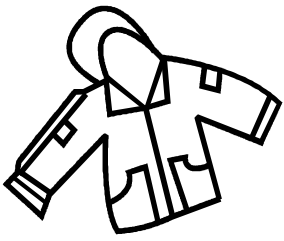

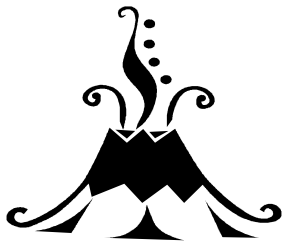
WELCOME TO FALL!
