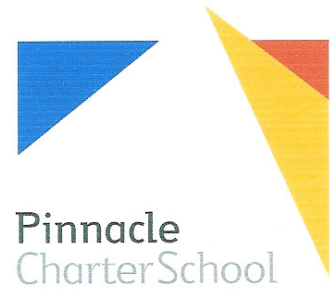

**ELA/Communication****Story "How I Spent My Summer Vacation" by Mark Teague**

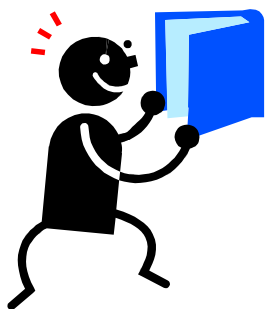
